Teaching in the Baba Temple
February 2000



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Swami: De-charging is not running properly. It's like a huge purification is running here since Christmas, huge purification is running. I have a huge doubt before the fire puja is running, huge vibrations, so sensitive and strong vibrations. Any questions?

Virginia: After three months Swami, how much are we supposed to learn? Are we going to be able to work with that information?

Swami: On Guru Purnima day, like again in ten days giving big workshop. It's very big talking about supernatural tantrics, supernatural powers, miracle systems. On Guru Purnima, around that period.

Student: If we don't take the Sanskrit, will we be able to understand on Guru Purnima still?

Swami: No problem my talks is very simple. Every person have to eat well, sleep well, take care their health and open their heart to understand Sanskrit. Nobody didn't teach me exactly, the English. To me before that I decided it's not possible, I gave up. I gave up English, finally I made it forty-five, fifty percent. It's big hard work to me to understand somebody's accents. Only few people frequency I understands very easily.

Myuri: Realistically Swami, in three months how much will we learn?

Swami: Twenty percent. If you do hard work, you will jump sixty percent. Then after, you can make it. I will give some helping clue points, like every 5,000 words. First you have to learn A, B, C, D, E, F...like that. Like a-p-p-l-e, apple. Taking in Sanskrit the word, taking the letters and switching it, making another word. That's it.

Then making sentences, “Ramakrishna is a crazy guy.” “Guy crazy is Ramakrishna,” how we assemble in a proper way but we have to learn in Sanskrit keeping the words, making sense. When you got that, you can read anything. You have to learn fifty percent Telugu, fifty percent Sanskrit, fifteen percent Kanada. Pure Sanskrit doesn't help you to read any manuscripts, you have to first learn Telugu then Sanskrit. Telugu and Kanada eighty percent similar but meanings is little bit difficult. It's very difficult, if you don't know any language, big accidents! (Laughter)

When I came in America, huge fear. I have no idea what they're talking, simply watching their mouth, hmmm? (Laughter) It's so interesting watching their mouth, guys! In one minute at least I can find a small word what they're talking. Hardly I'm understand. If someone want to speak, I make them write on the paper, then I'm taking dictionary, oh gosh, ok!

Where is the clean, you can maintain very pure vibrations is there, if there is no clean - no chance. If you make the clean even in your room, wherever you stay, it makes it so comfortable and peaceful. Good fortune is under your feet. This is true. Good luck, good fortune is with you when your room is very clean. If it's dirty, crazy, the demons energy will come there. In the *Vedas* you can check. When you go somebody house to heal, in the house if you see lot of dirty wear, change their habit to make sure they clean their home. Maybe I'm firing my two priests, no chance! Their only duty is to keep that area clean. You can hear lot of bugs, crickets. To me the crickets, the snakes comes there, then after, the animals comes there to sleep, they has to maintain certain smell, good fragrance.

Gaya: Swamiji, today we made a seva list so those who stay in the ashram, they have a duty so everything gets done.

Swami: Please!

Gaya: It's a beautiful gift because it gives us the opportunity to do something with no attachment. It's a gift of love.

Swami: Every person, like one hour. Whatever it takes to clean the ashram, do it. If you're making your own negativity, it's very danger. You understand? Sometimes I'm very crazy, but the people have to understand to fix it, make sure everything is clean up.

In northeast, steps is broken, everyday I'm seeing that. In nighttimes when I'm meditating, lot of crickets, making noise, mosquitoes. Just three rupees mosquito coil! You know how much hospital fees for getting malaria? I experienced that, huge hell getting malaria in India. In India mosquitoes is very poison, one bite it's enough. So, ok guys if everybody have the time we can go now and cleaning the temple?

Students: Yes.

Swami: We can do, then you can meditate in the hall.
