Swami Goes Over Vaastu Test Answers  
Talk at the Ashram  
March 19, 2007



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**Swami:** Good afternoon, guys. How many people is done so far, the Vaastu? Everybody done, eh? Hanuman, you made it? Ok, what is the solution for the first problem?

Hanuman: With the northwest entrance, it's best if they made an entryway - move the door to the west-north.

**Swami:** Understand what he's saying? Why can't you stand up and talk? You can explain there. Do you have the laser? Like a laser point?

Hanuman: This entrance is inauspicious. And so, one idea I had was to build a wall here... an entrance door, but if they had to keep this door, make an entry way, and make a door on this wall here so you're facing east when you walk in. The other option is to close this door up and put the door on this side if you need a door in this corner of the house. This street focus is inauspicious, and they need to stop using. They can donate it to the city or put a small garden here or they can sell it, or they can buy this property and try to create at least a 20-foot barrier. Otherwise, they need to build some walls really, thick to try to create a barrier.

**Swami:** Good. You understand? How many people agree, how many people disagree with that? Disagree Becca?

Becca: One slight problem is you have to be careful not to use up too much space to the north. If you encroach on that and make the space less than that which you have in the south, you have to build something in the south so that it's equal.

**Swami:** This area, northwest area is purchasing the headaches. You know that? And the entrance in the northwest, you're losing the property. You know that and northwest street hitting, legal fights and unnecessary quarrels, fights, disturbances, thefts, and no mental peace. You always want to travel, you won't be in that house, you're all the time traveling guy. That is the defects this property who has it.

The remedy for that, no matter what, the northwest entrance, this entrance need to cut it, or still if you have the northwest entrance here, you can make it one more little step here, come, enter. You know what I'm saying? Come towards little bit east then enter the house. Even itself, if the entrance is here... for example, this door belongs to this Mandir northwest. If they really need to use that... for example, where Gustav is sitting, I need to build one more wall there, innerly another fifty percent, then come out. You understand?

So, he can use it, still he can come out, get in. You cannot use straightly, come in from the northwest no matter what - period. And we do have the ashram having the northwest street hitting focus. What we done it, we built huge, gigantic walls, thick walls like what Hanuman said. That's good. And we putted a little Ganesh temple here. Then everybody, whoever coming, then we're come towards the east, then there is a northeast entrance, again east-north entrance into our ashram. Then street focus we have street hitting it.

If you're coming from here... to this point... if you look at that from the Gagan Mahal outside, the street it came like this, then entered like that. From this point the people started to looking it, straightly going hitting these apartments is here, the apartments also, these apartment, northeast street hitting to the eye power. If you went anybody to the Gagan Mahal, that area edge, there is the Rama temple ending. From that huge neem trees, the street completely going...is getting curved. The street always counts eye power hitting, where is your eye first immediately looking it.

Once you're coming here, whole your south apartments is northeast street hitting here. Once it it's turned, then again, it's hitting northwest - that's another dangerous point. We builded the walls and we putted a Ganesh temple there. Clear? Number two. What is the problem, Monika T.?

Monika T.: Same property, southwest pool, northeast swimming pool. How to fix it? What are the defects they are going to face? If it is good, what is good? What types of problems are they facing?

**Swami:** So, what is your answer?

Monika T.: A northeast swimming pool will bring prosperity and success, but a southwest swimming pool will bring very negative results. You don't know how it will hit - tragedy, life risk... If a southwest swimming pool is used, it's even a greater danger.

**Swami:** Ok, in that house, that person he likes southwest swimming pool, he likes northeast swimming pool, he wants to keep both. What is your remedy?

Monika T.: You're serious?

**Swami:** I'm serious.

Monika T.: Well, I would add to the northeast, and I would add some height to the southwest, some kind of building in the southwest that they use, like a round building...

**Swami:** Doesn't matter. Doesn't matter. Still, they can keep it?

Monika T.: No, I would advise not keeping it.

**Swami:** In the worst case, if you really want to keep the swimming pools...the house height is let's say 40 feet or 30 feet - make the northeast swimming pool 30 feet to 35 feet. The southwest swimming pool, make it fifty percent of its depth. Understand? Fifty percent of... like 15 feet depth. Whatever your house height, need to maintain this northeast ground otherwise, it's completely dead. This need to cut off, this need to go more depth.

If I want to make a swimming pool in the northeast...already I told it in the Tirumala temple... if I want to build a lake, first I have to measure the Gopuram height. This length of this Mandir two times, and a little more than height, then we need to drill it, make it bigger, then it really gives it more power. Making it simple like 6 feet depth, like 9 feet depth, it doesn't help. How depth you are - that counts, the ground. The house, how tall it is, then depth you're going to first, priority. Second priority, at least count your bedroom height where you really sleep. If the bedroom is fifteen feet height, no matter what... If you have the swimming pool in the northeast, no matter what - make a little bit higher in the bedroom. That is second advisable.

Third is, always make the swimming pool round any directions, any corner. Whenever you're building it, in the worst case never built square, square swimming pool. You know what I'm saying? Make it round one. That edges is very dangerous to hitting. If it is swimming pool like this, this edge, if it is a house is here, this edge hitting - no. That's called... we call, it is a sula putu. Before I mentioned that sula putu, or sora putu. Sula is a very powerful word, sula - clear? Ok, what is the third problem?

Monika T.: Same house, northeast kitchen, northeast toilet hole, septic tank, southwest high inside the house. The bedroom is more than the septic tank. The septic tank is five feet. Southwest height is nine feet like Swami's bedroom southwest of the Mandir. Compared to the fire pit, it's almost ten feet higher, compared to the water fountain eighteen feet down.

**Swami:** What are the problems here, what are you going to fix it, Clint Thompson?

Nityaanada: Well, the kitchen in the northeast is a problem and that burns their money - they can't keep any money. Also, there's no health and relationships there. There's conflict. The Northeast septic hole is negative because it's polluting the water element. But it's positive because it's a hole in the northeast, so... and also it's balanced. The southwest height is higher than that, which helps. The

southwest bedroom is positive having a southwest bedroom like that. So, if they can move the kitchen either to the southeast first priority, or northwest...

**Swami:** You're not catching my point here. I given the fire in the northeast. Same point again, I given the water in the northeast - septic tank, I given the both - one is positive, some kind of positive again, it's negative. Again, I've given one positive southwest height, then the septic tank. What are you going to do?

Nityaanada: Well, move the septic tank a little bit, either east or north and dig a hole there.

**Swami:** They don't have any space. They have to keep it there.

Nityaanada: Move the kitchen...

**Swami:** They love the kitchen... Once if I ask somebody, don't raise anybody hands... They love the kitchen. This very, very important subject, guys. You really need to learn this subject. This is one of the most dangerous, very important subjects in your lives - very important subject. Northeast kitchen, they don't want to move it. What is another alternate you're giving it, Becca?

Becca: Extend to the northeast - build more.

**Swami:** They don't have space. Aghni?

Aghni: To make the septic tank deeper?

**Swami:** What is the benefit to make the septic tank deeper? Then you're damaging southwest, eh? It is a negative, or positive? It is a negative, but it is a kind of positive. Alcohol it is good, but it is dangerous. Northeast kitchen, they like it. Northeast toilet - septic tank is there. How to fix that problem? There is many houses I seen it. You want one more day? Today we can complete this. Yes, Eric?

Eric: If you put a deep 20 foot plus hole in the northeast and put deep water there directly under the northeast of the house under the kitchen...

**Swami:** Digging a hole? Putting the water?

Eric: Underneath the house, like a cave.

**Swami:** You're ruining the life, the house of the beauty.

Student: Extend the kitchen to the southeast...

Gautam: Build a pool in the north, more prosperity...

Guenther: Put a light in the southeast and have it burning 24 hours. You gave this remedy in 2001.

**Swami:** Yes, that's make sense, it's like a big light, big fire, kind of big powerful all the time burning in the southeast. That's only way you can fix the northeast kitchen. I think I given before this remedy.

Guenther: 2001.

**Swami:** Which year?

Guenther: 2001 you gave it to Joey. I know because I had the northeast kitchen...

**Swami:** Still, you're holding that house?

Guenther: Well, my parents do, yes.

**Swami:** They're doing in southeast, oil light?

Guenther: No, my mom would freak out - she's afraid of fire. You have another remedy, Swami?

**Swami:** You have to make the southeast fire.

Monika T.: Swami, how in terms of the septic tank, how much is that handling that?

**Swami:** No problem, if southwest is height, no problem. That's why I given the mark there. If anybody have the northeast septic tank, put the southwest height. To your apartment (Southwest apts.) the northeast is a septic tank, it's northeast but I given the height more than that in the southwest where is the dhaba. The backside height is almost a littler higher so no problem.

Student: How big a fire should we have in the southeast?

**Swami:** Don't burn your house. Like once if you go in southeast, like big light it is there, firelight.

Student: All the time, non-stop?

**Swami:** Whenever you're going in the house it needs to be burn. The kitchen maximum, you burn two, three hours food - two hours you cook that but that light, you can put a picture of somebody and put a big light, big candle all the time burning - powerful candle, no problem. But these only temporary remedies, it's not a hundred percent fixing. It's not a hundred percent fixing it, what I given before with no compromise. If you followed that, you're done. Pretty good you're ok, temporary remedies.

This door, northwest door... this is a dangerous, no matter what. That's why we closed it. You seen, since years am I using this? But I am using this door, west south. How much I'm perfect on it? If I use this one weekly, two, three times, I use that door (northeast), in a day ten, fifteen times, all movement is going that way, but only I use weekly twice, thrice, this (southwest). So, no problem... even that's why one of the main reasons that downstairs bedroom I can't able to sleep there. There's a more meaning in it energetically too. It's kicking me out. It is kicking me out.

Pretty good I'm using whole Mandir, all places. Some time, I go in the garden. I sleep in the northeast. I go in the southeast. Sometimes I go all the way on the roof. Even the energy want to play on me, I'm making the energy confused. You know what I'm saying? Sometimes I sleep in my office. Many times, I sleep in my office, from the chair, just come out sleep there. Out. That's it. Sometimes I sleep in my Theatre Room. So, my movements...movements is very important. The whole Vaastu linked with movements. Even there is terrible bad Vaastu, how your movements will making it again, access it.

Your facings, your directions walking... Even you're anti-Vaastu property, super negative anti-Vaastu property, how your movements you're going through, that helps you. It's super advisable facing east, facing north, northeast, east-north. Keep go. Your success is all the time with you. If keep hitting south and west - your failures is all the time with you. Saddam Hussein, he foughted with which country that is? Iraq.

Student: Kuwait.

**Swami:** He went to southwest. Saddam Hussein went to the southwest. You can check on the graph - no way you can get, win it. America is pure southwest - that is dominating. From southwest to the movements, who have the north and east...if you have a house in southwest, if you purchase an office in the southwest of your house... like our journey... This is my house like a hundred, two hundred feet later I had an office in my southwest. I can't success for a while, for two, three years really problems. I can go hit in the north and the northeast side, like one hundred feet, two hundred feet, one kilometer, two kilometers easily I can win it. I can make my business make a super success, successfully. That much power is there. You understand? Is it clear, Luzia?

Luzia: You mentioned having an office as a fix for a north house, building an office in the southwest...

**Swami:** It takes time. Once if you have south more property, then you can build something higher than it. That is another remedy, will come in the next questionnaire that.

Jaycee: Can I ask you a question? You said Krishna Devaraya... facing Hampi, then you said he moved northeast, east-northeast to Penukonda before going to Chandragiri.... But on the map, it looks like east-southeast?

**Swami:** East-south, it's almost... it's ok. He came to Penukonda but he didn't get real succeed here. He really got succeed in Chandragiri.

Hanuman: There's something important that I'm missing about the fire in the southeast, fixing the water element in the northeast. There's something I need to understand. Something with the elements is happening and I don't get it. I don't understand it. Is it that the fire element in the kitchen, is somehow, being affected by the water in the northeast? So, you need to build that fire? What is it, what am I missing with the fixes with that fire in the southeast?

**Swami:** Fire element belongs to southeast. For example, southwest I have the dhuni. If you take the whole property in our ashram, southwest, put that way, the southwest fire let's say it's northeast too. Then immediately what I did it, I gave the water in the northeast. Southwest fire is there, but I given the water purely in the northeast. But dhuni is not totally in the southwest, kind of south, southeast. You know what I'm saying? But this fire pit is also a little dangerous. The inside Mandir fire is a little dangerous, but we never, ever all the time do fire pujas. We like that, raise the energy, cool down, close it. Clear?

Hanuman: So, if someone had a kitchen in the southeast and they never used the fire, is that going to be creating problems for them, they never create fire in their southeast?

**Swami:** Problems? Yes. You have like that in your house?

Hanuman: Sometimes I have the raw foods.

**Swami:** Raw foods?

Hanuman: No cooking. No stoves, no. So, a raw foods person should maybe have a fire in the southeast to help with the fire energy?

**Swami:** Are you married?

Hanuman: No.

**Swami:** Uh, that's why. (laughter). It's ok, man. What is the next problem?

Monika T.: Ok, the next problem is a southeast cut, northwest cut, and northeast cut. What are the problems and how you're going to fix it?

Chinello: The northeast cut is super dangerous - not advisable...cutting prosperity, so it's not advisable. The northwest and southeast cuts are ok. So, the main problem would be the northeast cut. So, to fix that, you could extend the property to the north and east to create a northeast extension to close off that northeast cut.



**Swami:** Even though any Vaastu book on the planet, any Feng Shui's, any energy channels, whoever they talk, never ever play with northeast. Never, ever play with northeast. Once if you have northeast cut - walk out, simply walk out. There is no, any remedy for that. Having no heart to make your life is a foolishness. It's a little tricky, ok southeast cut - no problem. Southwest cut - don't worry. Northwest cut, it's ok. Middle north cut, ok. Middle east cut, ok. But northeast make it a square or little bit extend like that.

But you cannot extend the Northeast like a round, again, it's cut. Northeast extension, never ever be round - it's a golden statement. Northeast never every be round. Northeast needs to be a little square, then almost sixty percent of your problems is gone in the house, sixty percent headaches is gone. So that's needs...even it counts the house, it counts the ground, it counts the building, and it counts the ground too. Then no matter the elements you're putting here and there, you're getting survived but this pure cut-off the northeast - dead, immediate powerful anti-actions is there. Clear? Life risks purely life risks.

**Myuri:** Can you cut the property to eliminate those cuts so there's less space in the south than in the north?

**Swami:** Why you taking risks? Never ever play with northeast. In the worst case you can make it...if it is a cut, then you can make it completely direct this. But there is no movements from here to there, no roof attachments. It's very harder. Even one roof attached, that's you are in dangerous. You can make it complete cut like that, but once it's cut, it's done, over. So, you need to cut it, make it like a person can walk between middle and this to this building to this building. Even this is a ground, if it is a ground, somebody, you need to donate it to somebody in what they used to it, northeast cut. You clear? Yes, Chinello?

**Chinello:** If someone has a northeast cut, I know you can't play with that... What if at the same time there's a really steep northeast slope?

**Swami:** Doesn't matter. Number fifth?

**Monika T.:** Northeast is huge mountain, southwest is gigantic slope, southeast gigantic mountain - what problems are the people facing? What is the remedy for this? They have to live in this house, but how are you going to fix it? Southeast pretty, powerful hill, northeast pretty, powerful hill, once the two hills are there, it means automatically southwest slope, isn't it? The remaining house is good. We're only talking these points. Each question has its own block.

**Swami:** Tobias.

**Tobias:** I didn't really hear the question.

**Swami:** I know, you're somewhere else.

Tobias: Well, southwest slope is pretty, bad - the accidents, sickness, depression... northeast - huge mountain also bad. Southeast, again mountain also problems - makes you work, one part, but problems with women.

**Swami:** You cannot fix this. There's no solution for this. Southwest slope - goodbye. South slope, west slope, even north slope, east slope - ok but southwest - period. They gave one-billion-dollar check, free donation of the house. Take a palace. South - gigantic slope, you'll be dead, broke. Northeast mountain - depressions, addictions, drugs, purely Vairagya. They don't care what they want they don't have any ambitions. You know what I'm saying? So, this type of all kind of mental irritable actions will start in the northeast mountains. Southeast mountain the ladies will become very powerful. Ladies will be super active, but also, they're having lot of tons of headaches. There's huge chance they might turn as the widows.

The same problem is a Mr. Mani's house in his village. There is a hundred houses. At the moment, ninety widows is there. In that village, same problem, ninety widows - all the husband's gone. Even the electrician, Mr. Mani, you know that big mustache guy...strong fatty guy? He went to the village. Luckily on the day, Mr. Suri, he has to climb that electrical wires to fix it. And the tractor driver, Mani, he climbed, and he fixing it. Immediately the electricity's passed before they turned off in some station. They don't know, just all of sudden they made it on. His two hands got burned, completely as a skeleton, completely burned. They removed that two hands - he's dead.

Before he's going to the village, I didn't give permission to him. Don't go. Mani's house has very good Vaastu, but the circumstances is very dangerous. Same southwest is gigantic slope to the village. That whole village is suffering. It's not whole your house, once if you're entering in any village, you can tell the village how successful they are. Once if you entrance any village, what is the entrance? Any village you can started to count. Some villages have entrances (in) the pure southwest. Those villages have all the time violence, fighting with another village, violence people, fear. Some village entrance, pure north hitting - they're lucky prosperity. Some village, they builded it with a huge mountain in the east, all the houses simply you can say, 'white flag.' Recently, from here ten kilometers, whole village they vacated it. They locked their doors. Now they're constructing another village. The east gigantic mountain, the north gigantic mountain, they went around the hill. Again, they're building there almost four hundred and fifty houses. Even the newspapers, they're writing negative rationalization on the Vaastu. "Nowadays, science is developing huge! These guys is stupids la, la, la, la, la, la." Crazy things.

But the villagers, they strongly believe on the Vaastu. They left. Does it make sense? You can see that, go that village, you can make a video of that whole village as a testimony. And some villages have a lot of factions. If their entrance is a little funny to the village headman, I made them to change their entrances in a beautiful, auspicious way. It helps the village. Village, whole village people movement going out. Like whole our ashram people, we have very good

movements. You go the east, turn the north then again go the east. Then once you went the highway, south is height. Going the south, even the height going to Bangalore, it will really pick up, then all the way north slope. Ok, what is the next?

Monika T.: Problem number six: East amazing slope, southeast amazing slope, from southwest to northwest, super high mountains. How we are going to fix this? What problems are there? What types of headaches are they facing? What is a remedy?

**Swami:** What is your solution?

Monika T.: Well, make sure that the south slope inside the property... there is no south slope in the property. Put up a fence and boundary and then create a northeast movement outside of the boundary and if possible, extend the land to the east to include more of the east slope of the property.

**Swami:** You cannot fix this, too. South slope, no, even you have north slope, east slope, south is really slope - no. No, don't get compromised.

Monika T.: Can I ask a question on that because of the church's Vaastu? That has a big south slope. That has a...

**Swami:** Church?

Monika T.: Laytonville.

**Swami:** Yeah, yeah, I know that.

Monika T.: So, there you put up a fence, but it has a north slope - bigger huge north slope. How is that a fix there and then this way...

**Swami:** The lake is there - it's helping but south slope he's not using. That's ok, but east is height, west is height, whole his movements is going the north. He's getting barely surviving there. I mentioned him to build in the southwest house. Exactly I showed the point, big point, this area then it doesn't count south. Still, you're using southwest there, using southwest but your slope is only tiny bit southeast. It is what I seen, what I observed, it is twenty-five feet tilted to the north. It's ok, but the lake, more than your house, more than maybe ten times, twenty times, ten times, that's really surviving. Until to build the southwest, there is no success to that - period. Until to build something to Southwest, no success.

**Swami to Nityaanada:** You're smart, huh? (Laughter)

Nityaanada: I expected this question will come.

Falk: Can you do what you did, bring all the dirt to the south and change the slope?

**Swami:** Yeah, no problem.

Falk: But then the next property (to the south) is lower than that. How does that affect it? You have a huge pile of dirt, you have a slope to the north, but then the next property is much lower than your property.

**Swami:** How much you have the north, that's main counting.

Falk: So, people can fix it if they have like a huge amount, if they have like ten feet, twenty feet, thirty feet?

**Swami:** No problem. Fixing all the time, putting the weight in the south as much as you can, you're an unbelievable success - period. Putting the south tons of weight, dirt, stuff, rocks... weight, whatever it is. Even the land is jig-jog, throw it, don't use it, just throw the rocks, then you see the game. The west mountain what we have it...once if you have a west mountain, I'm telling, even I don't want to work...if you don't want to work-who have the property here, I'm sorry, you have to work. (laughter)

If you own a property here, you say, "No, I want to take a simple relaxing diksha, peaceful..." It won't put you really, peaceful - you have to work - things keep moving it. That's a west power, that's a west power. Ok, what is the next?

Monika T.: Number seven: Southwest kitchen, northwest bedroom, northeast cut. What are the problems? How they going to fix it?

**Swami:** Next.

Monika T.: Number eight: Round property, square house in the middle. Is it advisable or not? Water is around the house. Is it advisable or not?

**Swami:** What is your answer?

Monika T.: Well, a round property is a northeast cut, so I'd say, absolutely no - you can have a round house but not a round property.

**Swami:** How many people is disagree with this round property, a round property? How many people will accept this? Gustav.

Gustav: You said the first, priority is to have a square property, the second is a rectangle and the third is round. So, I said, "Well, it's ok." Otherwise, I would believe what Monika T. said about it being a northeast cut. I found that in my papers, so I accepted it.

**Swami:** In your papers?

Gustav: Yeah, in a handout.

**Swami:** But again, the water is around.

Gustav: My solution is if the water is less than the house site, then it's possible to live there.

**Swami:** Water is in southwest in the bed - around.

Gustav: That's not good. It should not be in the southwest quadrant. But if you live in the northeast with your bed - water is ok.

**Swami:** Who will agree for this? Agree? Patrick, explain.

Patrick: I don't see how a round property has any negative or positive features - it's neutral. So how can that affect negative? If you put a square house in the middle of it, that's different because then you're taking a part of your northeast and cutting it, so you lose some northeast. I don't agree to put a square house in the middle of it. I'd put a round house in the middle of it. If I had to put a square house in the middle of it, I'd cut the property. So... but I don't see how that's negative. If a round house is there, ok, why not a round property?

**Swami:** Tatyana.

Tatyana: I would say I wouldn't accept it because the northeast cut.

**Swami:** Where is exact the northeast to that? If it is a round house - accepted. If the round house we accept it as not a northeast cut, why can't we accept as a round property is not as a northeast cut? When you're accepting our hut as good, why can't we accept the round property? We do... can accept round properties but where you're going to put your square house - that's a dangerous. Then you have to be play... The water can be around the house, no problem, but if you have a house here...house...then you have to make it here...a little garden, like a square in the round property. You know what I'm saying?

Student: Where are directions?

**Swami:** Let's say, south, north...then you built a house here...then you built a garden - no problem but in your house, southwest bedroom, the water very dangerous. If anybody sleeping in the southwest like a swimming pool, they have a... you have no idea. In London they gave me a room on top of the swimming pool. I'm serious. I have no idea. That whole night I am bumpy. I am vomiting, coughing... I started to cough from ten p.m. until to five a.m. more than fifteen, twenty times I throwed-up. My next door is Tatyana. Then she heard, "What's going on with the Swami?" Then I took my compass, I tilted here, I tilted this...the compass also playing very funny. Is it true, Tobias? In that room, wherever I go, it's showing different angle. One time it's showing north this,

again going this, north is swinging this. By morning five o'clock, I get out from that room. Then I have enter, walk, then I noticed under my room there's a beautiful big swimming pool in the southwest area - such a lucky man. I enjoyed in London then I cancelled to the next, Germany. Thank you. Super sick. Super sick. It's a true. Never take risk things. Yes Patrick?

Patrick: For how long did that affect you?

**Swami:** If I'm sensitive, it affects within hours.

Patrick: How long after did it affect on you?

**Swami:** Let's say for a week. For one week.

Gustav: Can you stay on a waterbed in the northeast? Is that possible?

**Swami:** What's he saying?

Monika T.: In the northeast can you sleep in a waterbed?

**Swami:** Yes. You clear?

Luzia: Is it true that the more we purify ourselves, the more sensitive we are to Vaastu? It hit you right away, but would it hit a normal person that strong?

**Swami:** Immediately, no matter what. Yes? Any questions. Generally, my thoughts, my words is a little faster I receive. Whenever I'm receiving super positive, again same time, I'm getting negativity. But I have to be, protect that. So, it's very danger...it's terrible, really terrible. Next? I think we answered it.

Monika T.: It's the water around the square house. What's the difference there?

**Swami:** Square house.

Monika T.: Now you added the water element around that.

**Swami:** Bedroom in the house, in the middle Southwest.

Monika T.: Right.

**Swami:** Water around the bed...

Monika T.: Not only the bed, but around the whole house.

**Swami:** No problem.

Monika T.: So, then the following question is, southwest entrance to the property and a small, tiny bridge across the water and open in the open property in the

northeast, a beautiful diamond (dining?) kitchen, and in the northwest an extra guest room. What's the problem? Is it right or not? Does everybody understand this? What is your answer, Patrick?

Patrick: Well, the entrance is a bad point. And I thought the kitchen also is taking up northeast space. The guest bedroom I had problems also because we still have more space in the south and west, so...I though they were all minus points. Normally having a guest room in the northwest is ok because people are moving out alright, but it seems like a little too much weight in the northwest.

**Swami:** How you're going to fix it?

Patrick: Well, leave these things where they're at and start there? I can't move anything, or I can move the buildings?

**Swami:** What's he saying? Moving the kitchen?

Patrick: Yeah. Moving the kitchen southeast. Entrance you'd have to move northeast to northeast and the guesthouse I would move... well, I don't know.

**Swami:** Nityaanada.

Nityaanada: If they need to keep your building here, then yes, the southwest entrance is bad, has to be only a northeast entrance to that island.

**Swami:** That's not...ok?

Nityaanada: And put a big hole... put something very, very high in the southwest, higher than everything else like a big structure. It doesn't have to be a building it just has to be height.

**Swami:** Ok.

Nityaanada: Then I think it's ok. Um... Because it makes a huge northeast movement, everybody's moving to the northeast all the time for their food and the guests do come to eat. And, um, that middle house surrounded by water... I think that's a very, very peaceful place to live. I think one problem is that it's so balanced by the water that I don't think you can go out into the world and have a big influence there.

**Swami:** Still, you can do it but... before, any fort in India, around the fort there is water. Around the fort there is a big water, and they release the crocodiles. If anybody climb the fort, it's very difficult. It's only the movement is very bad here, or they has to come... somewhere inauspicious entrance... you need to come around, then its ok, no problem. Even the northeast kitchen, the water is around - that balances it. No problem.

Myuri: The water to the south of the?

**Swami:** No problem.

Monika T.: Problem number eleven: House with amazing east, northeast extension, is it advisable or not? And the northeast extension is three hundred feet and its sixty feet in the southwest.

**Swami:** Becca.

Becca: If you draw the quadrants around that property, that's not a northeast extension, its southwest. Sometimes you get the opposite of what you want.

**Swami:** So, what you need to do?

Becca: Well, the smart thing to do would be to cut off that southwest extension and give it away or sell it.

**Swami:** This one?

Becca: You could cut it off to the west.

**Swami:** Like this way?

Becca: Yeah. Yeah. Sell or give away the southwest...

**Swami:** You give this one out?

Becca: Yeah. Get rid of it.

**Swami:** This is more prosperity place. You should not cut this.

Becca: Oh.

**Swami:** Or you could do two things. You can break, can get until here if it's possible, otherwise, little bit cutted here, make a little entrance gate here - Part one. Part two, always it's advisable to go a little northeast like this. Whenever northeast is extension, it's not that much advisable to cut the north...southwest. Southwest is for power, money. Then it adds more prosperity to the northeast. Too much northeast extension is an extension of the southwest, too much. I think Mr. Reddy's book, he also he's mentioned that.

Monika T.: This many entrances in all the places, northwest, west-north, west-south, southwest, Southeast, east-south, middle east, middle north, northeast.

**Swami:** So, what're you going to do?



Monika T.: Well, first fix the property, and definitely remove the negative entrances in the west-south and the southwest and depending on how you are extending your property...

**Swami:** No matter what guys, never walk inauspicious entrances. Even that trick you hear, that's my game...to how your mind works on the Vaastu. Inauspicious entrances don't get compromised. Walk always movement in perfect entrances. You know what I'm saying? You can have like hundred entrances to the big palace. Certain doors need to close - certain doors need to open, period. Yes, Brett?

Brett: When you're fixing the property, I thought you said, never ever cut the northeast?

**Swami:** This much northeast, that's not healthy. I can make to this property...we have the northwest, northeast, again the northeast. I completely separated as the divided parts. If I made a one big block, this is southwest extension. Our ashram also, you can take a graph (map) you can look at that. Make from the northwest zero - point one, two until the southwest, completely went southwest extension. It's need to divide.

Brett: So, divide the northeast instead of cutting the southeast...

**Swami:** Each block, make it as own extensions, for example, if it is like this, little extension here, ok; little extension here, ok, but if you make a huge extension like this, mmm-mmm. Going like if you Mandir is like this, then if you went whole like this, southwest extension. You know what I'm saying? Even if you went like this, little jig-jog. Come Shiva Temple is up it's not square. Still, we have our land there, up and downs - Tch! - no compromise!

You little property good northeast extension - cut it, another road. Make another property northeast extension. You can still keep build the constructions towards east and north. I'm giving the northeast extension to that. You should not go, keep going to the south, southwest extensions to building it - you are in dangerous. Even if you tried it, you cannot build it. It won't take that much. It won't give that much, how do you call it, it won't happen that easily. You have to purchase the problems.

That same building like what I built in the northwest, I can do in southwest - no guts, put that way. It's a beautiful weight if I build it there. That huge, that much length, if I build it like up like 400 feet height, that's supreme power. Before getting supreme power, I have to mentally prepare to face any headaches. But anyhow, I'm going to start very soon, I have to. Step by step. You can see once I started that, small, tiny controversy problems, this and that, started to shaking, but I'm finding little funny way to play with that energy, build first water tank in southwest, big one, the entire this rooms the southwest of the outside of the property, then little more south property purchasing. We have 400 feet, little more 100 feet purchasing. After 100 feet returns, this property will becomes

northwest. This property will become northwest. You can build northwest very easily, no problem. Then, again you cut off that wall, come back again normal way. You know what I'm saying?

Thousands of times, thinking, thinking, thinking to drawing it. We'll see but once if I build that, one big Mother Divine temple, one top of several rooms, I don't who is lucky guys can be staying in there. Done. I cannot move to there. Have to stay here. I cannot move there. But that property, guys, can punch very powerfully. Yes? Same house?

Monika T.: Yes, and this house has a swimming pool to the northeast and there's a swimming pool in the southwest and a huge lake in the northeast.

**Swami:** No problem, it's a lake, huge lake depth. Before I mentioned there, number fourteen?

Monika T.: Number fourteen same property, huge mountains, equal mountains all the way around.

**Swami:** No problem.

Eric: Swami, that last one there, um, it has a swimming pool there. It has a big lake there, but it also has a southwest swimming pool there. So, having that giant lake it makes it ok?

**Swami:** No problem. No problem. It's a dominating water is there. Dominating depth is there. Dominating water is there, so it won't hurt you that badly.

Eric: And also, the southwest extension is no longer a problem because of that lake?

**Swami:** No problem. No problem. With the lake water completely pulling out, it's pulling the negativity.

Myuri: If the lake is outside the boundaries?

**Swami:** This lake is here then its dangerous. If it is inside property, you're safe. If it is linked to your property, to your house to that lake, you're ok. It's the same like this before with Doug's house, I went there in nineteen...like ten years back, in America Doug's parent, their house they have the northeast lake. Yes, Chinello?

Chinello: Is the lake also dominating on inauspicious movements throughout the property? Like inauspicious entrances? Like for instance, bad entrances to the property. Does the dominating influence of the lake also balance the bad entrances?

**Swami:** Why you want to take the bad entrances? Take the good entrances. But the lake is very power, like a Tirumala Lake power - east height, south height, southeast height and southwest height and northeast gigantic lake, east entrance, northeast weight there inside temple, northeast is cut inside tiny bit temple. You seen it, the temple? It's northeast cut and east-south entrance, southeast entrance - lake is commanding.

Next to the water are a mountain - water is first power, the weight is second power. The weight and water both is supreme power. Supreme. Just our tiny bit swimming pool, our fountain is commanding. You have no idea. You go and just stay a little time there. I'm always sitting under that tree. From there, the energy receiving that vibrations - that's very power.

Monika T.: Swami, may I ask one...

Gustav: Is height third power? Height? You said, first water, weight and then height?

**Swami:** I don't know where you are. It's recorded.

Monika T.: Swami, one question. If you have a high mountain and then you have a slope, but the mountain is much higher than the slope, it's not the same principle as we're following there?

**Swami:** If it is the lake is there?

Monika T.: No lake, just mountain and slope.

**Swami:** Explain. Give me an example.

Monika T.: Ok. Let's say we have a west mountain and a south slope.

**Swami:** I won't stay there.

Monika T.: You won't stay there even if the mountain is really, huge and the slope is...

**Swami:** South...

Monika T.: South but it's not a twenty-five percent of what the height is.

**Swami:** I won't stay there.

Monika T.: Ok, so...

**Swami:** Especially south slope, I won't stay there.

Student: If there's a big lake there, in the northeast?

**Swami:** I'll stay if the lake is there, I'll stay. I know Nityaanada thinking happy now, "Oh my God, thank you!" (Laughter) No, the water is...water is power. In the auspicious place, precious place, the water is hitting there. Take off. Good, next. Everybody prepared for your fifty prayers, fifty prayers, five yantras, Nityaanada?

Nityaanada: Pranams.

**Swami:** Has to. Today's the test. I putted you guys, last night, 6 pm until morning 8 am in your rooms. What you done in your rooms? (The crowd murmurs and fidgets uncomfortably) Yeah? What is it, door in the northwest?

Monika T.: Number fifteen. Doors in the northwest, middle north, northeast, is it good Vaastu? He's using three doors. What kind of problems is he facing?

**Swami:** No matter what, he has to close the northwest then he can use the remaining doors. The problems is he is a super irritable and always going out from that property from that house. It's not healthy. Next?

Monika T.: Number sixteen. Another problem, he's sleeping in the northeast bedroom. Is it advisable or not?

**Swami:** No problem, northeast bed - no problem, you can sleep. I sleep in the northeast. It's a kind of bedroom, that area, relaxation. Who really having under huge pressure, try to spend in the northeast, any of your house, any of your property - go to the north and northeast everyday a little time. Walk then you can see how much relief you will get it. Ok? Good.

David: How come the book says northeast bedroom sleeping in the northeast bedroom brings chronic illness, health problems?

**Swami:** Northeast bedroom, generally you put the toilet there in the northeast too. That's why in the early days we warned that.

David: So, as long as your toilet is not in the northeast?

**Swami:** Its good property, especially the point here - northeast bedroom. If it is a house, east, west, north, south you can have one bedroom here, you can have one bedroom here, you can have one bedroom here, you can have one bedroom here. No problem.

But, if you cutted the southwest, if the southwest is cut in the property, then you're not having any eligible to sleep in the northeast bedroom. If there is no head, southwest, if there is no power then it's not advisable to go in the northeast. If it is really, square, then first priority - sleeping in the southwest, second priority in the southeast, third priority in the northwest, fourth priority in the northeast.

Before, Tobias' apartment, he's having a northeast bedroom and he putted me when I'm there in the northeast bedroom. But the toilet is in the good auspicious place, that's why I slept there. But I didn't slept very well because of...what the birds it is?

Tobias: Magpie.

**Swami:** Huge sound, unbelievable sound! Unfortunately, I opened the window... I don't know how to close it. I opened it and she putted in the northeast that huge rock with the light in it. You know, what we call that? What we call that Tatyana? That rock?

Tatyana: I think its salt stone.

**Swami:** Salt rock? Crystal. Huge crystal in my bedroom, in the northeast - ok, oh my God, fine. She fixed it a nice bed, ok, fine, so nice putting all the flowers and everything nice. But in northwest bedroom they're sleeping, but they're never... How many months you stayed in that house?

Tobias: Well, I was always working and then my holiday I spent...

**Swami:** Say again?

Tobias: I was always at work, like fourteen, fifteen hours a day to work and then my holidays I always spent somewhere else.

**Swami:** So, you never stayed in that house? Northwest bedroom makes you to...and also, it's a little bit northwest extension. Then it's huge northeast step slope. He's lucky successful guy but it got kicked out. If anybody want move from the property, you can do simple one thing - make entrance in the northwest. Any guest came in the house, he's really torturing you give him the northwest bedroom, make an intentional northwest bedroom to that. He won't stay. I'm serious, in his bedroom put in his northwest big weight, something big refrigerator facing him north sleep. [Laughter]. It's done. It's done. He'll find the hotel, he tells lot of excuses and run away - you can test it, you can see it.

Myuri: Swami, on this one you told, a bedroom in the northeast makes this a northeast cut and instead of a door outside, make an inside door to connect that room. Right now, it has an outside door to that bedroom in the northeast. So, we should have the door inside the house from the west going to the east?

**Swami:** Can. No problem.

Myuri: So, we should not have this door from outside in the northeast?

**Swami:** Still, you can have it. No problem. You can have it, no problem. I know what you're talking but... for example, if I make a room, one puja room there,

generally everyone makes one room as a puja room. Much time we never use that. In the puja room, normally you go morning hours like ten minutes, twenty minutes then evening times ten minutes, twenty minutes. You're not using really the northeast. The tricky point is you have to use as much as you can the northeast. That's the tricky point. That's why I'm telling you go walk in the northeast for little while. Go walk in northeast. If you're really using much time... of course you guys are really meditating a lot. You're meditating and you're sleeping there, fine, in the puja room. Am I answered you?

Myuri: Yes.

**Swami:** How much you're using the northeast, that's the point. Again, I have another question. To the Mandir main gate, to the northeast there is the fountain there. To the security guys, to them it's a southwest swimming pool, southwest pool there. To them, immediately adjoining northeast huge height. How much the security guys, that pool is affecting to them?

To the security guys, they have a huge west empty place, huge south empty place. In their southwest is a swimming pool. To them, they're always under tension they can't be peaceful sitting there. You know what I'm saying? They're always under tension. But they have pretty good northeast open place, too. But immediately, all the time standing there, they're not standing there happily. They're happy, but tension is there, bumpiness. Period. Ok, next.

Monika T.: Number seventeen. Same house, but one more house in the northeast bigger than the other house, it's actually not tilted, it also has pretty good entrances, northeast entrance. On the property, more space in the southwest, sixty feet, and not much space in the northeast, twenty feet. Overall, this house is a perfect square. This house also has good Vaastu.

**Swami:** There is only two remedies. Either they need to separate it or remove this. There is no any other option. Separate it or remove it. Next one.

Monika T.: Number eighteen. Same house - let's come to the roofs. The roof is sloped south 40 feet and north 45 feet. Is it advisable or not?

**Swami:** No problem.

Monika T.: Number nineteen. Again, the same house, the roof slopes east 60 feet and west 65 feet. Is it advisable or not?

**Swami:** East is?

Monika T.: Sixty.

**Swami:** West is?

Monika T.: Sixty-five.

**Swami:** What is your comment?

Monika T.: No, it's not advisable.

**Swami:** Clear.

Monika T.: Is there any remedy for that?

**Swami:** No. You cannot...especially in Germany, the houses what I noticed, is a majority of the playing with the energies with the roofs, guys. And the south more, empty space, the south... if the west slope is 60 and the east slope is 50 - no. Even if it is a 50/50 - ok. If it is a more, whatever you're making, it's falling out. Not only on the ground you're counting, the roof is also, you have to count. The roof slopes, you must, must, must count that. If it is straight, flat form, no problem. Gently sloping to the northeast - no problem. Anti-side as a bending even one feet more up, I won't recommend that. Then again you need to make it more space to build something, again make it more slope. Then it's advisable. That's why I given this question.

Volker: The northwest building, normally the north should be more open but there's a beautiful huge tree. How much does this affect?

**Swami:** Where?

Volker: The northwest building in front of the building, there's a huge tree.

**Swami:** Northwest building?

Volker: Northwest building, yea.

**Swami:** Oh, that one? That side? Yea? The tree?

Volker: Yes, that tree in the north.

**Swami:** Yeah? You want to cut that?

Volker: No, it's beautiful, but I wonder because the northeast should be open space usually and you also said that you cut many trees when you...

**Swami:** No, it's ok. That tree is not that more than height of that building. Even I'm counting this tree near the Ganesh, those two trees growing. Everyday I'm looking at it. How to cut that? (Laughter) Many times, two times it made fall off, broke off. You know that? Again, I'm expecting it's better to fall off. North - huge tree, huh-uh, no... But it's ok until to this big roof, then we can little bit trim it, make it smaller, make it a shorter. I cannot accept huge, gigantic grown that. Next?

Monika T.: Problem Number Twenty. From the southeast all the way to northwest is an ocean very close by one kilometer. You can see the water waves. You can feel the ocean waves. Is it advisable or not?

**Swami:** Paul.

Paul: You have water in the northeast to northwest but huge in the northeast.

**Swami:** You have water in northwest. You have water in the southeast. You have water in the northeast. One positive, two negative, which one you give priority?

Paul: Water in the southeast is not good.

**Swami:** Southeast water is, ok? Northwest water is, ok?

Paul: You have positive influence on the north, east, and northeast.

**Swami:** If I am there, I won't stay. Even today, this Mandir, southeast is south is a lake is there. It means this ashram has to maintain until the southwest building is started. The ladies will dominate it. You know what I'm saying? It's happening. The majority I have to depend on the ladies. No, I won't recommend that. Southeast water, northeast water, even the northeast water is there - I won't recommend that. Hmm-mm. Sometimes the rivers go like that. If you see the Vittala Temple in Hampi, same story, it's all the way river going from southeast to all the way northeast to come then northwest. You know what I'm saying? The Hampi river. That's why he depended on the ladies. Finally got crashed. He got crashed. I won't recommend that.

Monika T.: Same property, then the entrances are on the west-north and southwest. How much is it advisable?

**Swami:** Same property? The water is same?

Monika T.: The water is the same. Now we have two entrances in the southwest and the west-north.

**Swami:** If the other properties got failure, then you cannot take. Next.

Monika T.: So, the next problem/question. The house on this property, even though the water is there, and the entrance is in the northwest, he has a swimming pool in the southwest and a swimming pool in the northwest, and a swimming pool in the northeast. It's the same question? Oh.

**Swami:** You're brilliant, don't you think so? We done? How many questions more?

Monika T.: Four.



**Swami:** Yeah? Twenty-three, southeast swimming pool. To the ladies in the house, if you want to dominate your husband, you can have it. But the husband won't keep you happy too. The master won't keep you happy too, the boss not happy means, big friction there, big friction - so it's not advisable. Next.

Monika T.: Ok, problem Number Twenty-four. In the northeast is a house, in the east-north a gigantic river flowing to the northeast. If you throw a rock, it will jump in the river. What he has to do?

**Swami:** Nityaanada.

Nityaanada: Well, the river is super, auspicious, but the house placement and the land shape are not good. So, if he doesn't want to cut this land...I mean, you can cut this land and that place would be really, super.

**Swami:** Exactly. No matter what, you have a kind of one-billion-dollar check, just simply make it a beautiful...use as much as you can as less then make it access it. Even you're losing ten acres in south, 100 acres in the west, only you have 10 feet in the north, 20 feet in the east - get that. Don't think, "Oh my God, I lost 100 acres in my west, 50 acres in the south. Only I'm having 10 feet north, 5 feet east." You're still lucky. You know what I'm saying? Never, ever compromise that, simply cut-off. Forget it. Then?

Monika T.: Then, he's building a horse stable in the southwest, but he's living in the northeast. What types of problems is he facing? What are the drawbacks? What are the positive marks?

**Swami:** What are the problems there?

Monika T.: Well, the horse stable is tilted, so automatically that's a huge problem. Probably the horses are dominating in the house - the situation with the horses. (Laughter) There are problems with them, with that situation. There's a lot of height in the northeast, a lot of space to the west so it'll bring a lot of heartaches.

**Swami:** You lose a lot of money for the horses. The horses, it'll become big headache on your life, on your soul... It really does. So, you need to separate that. Come different entrance. Complete cut it, come different entrance. Make it really, as much as you can square, then you're ok. Once if it's cutted, having a good square, having a north good space, south cut it, make it really, square. Fine, can stay. No problem.

If it's already owned, if the horses already big building, then using different entrance, no problem. But, from this house if you want to construct here, that's a problem. First you need to separate it, then build it more height, then build it.

Hanuman: When you say separate it, are you talking about building walls and roads to divide it into different areas like you did in the ashram?

**Swami:** Yeah.

Hanuman: How effective is this against the Vaastu? I mean the negative effects are still being created with walls and roads?

**Swami:** Give me an example.

Monika T.: How effective are creating walls and like in this situation, to change the Vaastu even if you own both pieces of property and use them?

**Swami:** If you had different entrance, no problem, but you had to build something really height in your house ground. First priority - sell it. Second priority, if already a house exists, cut it, go the different road. Clear? Done?

Monika T.: The same property. He has a swimming pool in the northwest - another problem. He uses the swimming pool. He goes to the river and swims there too. He has some special boat. Every day goes in the boat. Everyday he comes back. What's he going to face the problems? What are the good benefits?

**Swami:** Nityaanada.

Nityaanada: He needs to cut that house into a good place then the river is so positive that he can probably go to that swimming pool. It's not the end of the world for him to go, as long as it's a separate piece of land.

**Swami:** Exactly. Separate it then use the boat. Go for two kilometers and come back. You are unbelievable lucky. If you have a river or lake in front of you, or an ocean in the east, if you're using that water, I will give a hundred percent guarantee you're a successful guy. You have to use that water. Even if you have a lot of north and east space. When you're using it, you're a successful guy, but the water is more power than the ground. Yes.

Monika T.: Ok, taking problem number twenty-seven, taking this whole Mandir, southwest is high, southeast is high and northwest instead of fifty percent, I'm only taking a smaller twenty percent, thirty percent. Why?

**Swami:** Why?

Monika T.: Because you're counting it as two separate spaces. You're private space and then the public space. And then that is your northeast of the private space otherwise, you would have an L-shaped private space. Now you have a U-shaped private space with a northeast that is lower.

**Swami:** Say again?

Monika T.: You've separated these two spaces - your living area and public area. Count them like two different ways, two sectors.

**Swami:** Which one is living area?

Monika T.: This area behind. Then the office you're counting as the northeast of that area. So that's why it's lower than any other part of the area, which is the same as this height.

**Swami:** That's ok, one part. If I fixed the northwest, height is there, if any northwest height is there, what happens?

Monika T.: Legal problems...

**Swami:** Any, whatever I have it, just keep going out. If you guys, if you want to stay in the Mandir, if I put in the northwest height, you don't want to stay in the Mandir. You don't have that peaceful meditation - that is the main tricky point.

Student: Next problem.

**Swami:** That's it. All four angles is height, seven feet, seven feet. Nityaanada.

Nityaanada: Well, that's balanced. It's peaceful for the family. It's like water in the middle, but it's not... but it can only last for a short time like one generation. And that balance makes it... I don't think they can come out into the world and influence the world. It's balanced for them. They're peaceful and happy, but they're not going to go out to punch the world. And then their children will have to get out. You couldn't stay there more than a generation.

**Swami:** Is it advisable or not?

Nityaanada: For a peaceful for that one family, yes, they could live there and be peaceful.

**Swami:** Why?

Nityaanada: Because everything is perfectly balanced. Vaastu is not really affecting on them.

**Swami:** In that house will they experience prosperity very well?

Nityaanada: No. But they'll have enough.

**Swami:** Just 50-50. Just 50-50. Can stay, ok, but not a hundred percent advisable. It's ok. Done? Good. Yes?

Guenther: A clarification concerning the Northwest Apartments, there's a southeast slope. The bathroom in the southeast, there's a southeast slope.

**Swami:** No problem. Southwest is height, isn't it?

Guenther: There's a bathtub, yes?

**Swami:** Thanks. So, what is the problem?

Guenther: Well, because there's a slope to the southeast in this room, and if the bathroom in the southeast is lower than the front room...

**Swami:** Say again?

Guenther: The bathroom door in the southeast is lower than the north room, the main room, the big room in the north, what's the effect?

**Swami:** I didn't get him.

Monika T.: He's saying the floor level in the southeast of that apartment is the lowest area of the apartment. Is that what you're saying, of the apartment?

Guenther: In the new apartments...

**Swami:** I know what you're talking. In the new apartments, southeast is a little slope in the bathroom. Is it correct?

Guenther: This is one aspect. The other aspect is also that the floor is lower than the main room floor.

**Swami:** No problem. No problem.

Guenther: What is the effect there?

**Swami:** But the tub is height there.

Guenther: Tub is height, yes.

**Swami:** That balances it. You're having an apartment there?

Guenther: Yes Guruji, I'm very happy, and another thing Swami, what is the Vaastu in a boat if you're a sailor?

**Swami:** What?

Guenther: If you're a sailor and you're traveling on a boat.

**Swami:** You are a slave.

Guenther: You are a slave? That's very bad.

**Swami:** Staying all the time on the water, you're a slave. Hmm-mm. So, by five...what time your dinner, guys? Five, six o'clock everybody coming, dividing

you're fifty mantras. Who don't know fifty mantras, fifty prayers? Yantras? Three yantras? Sri Chakra, Jesus Channels, Womb Chakra. Who don't know that? Tobias, you don't know that?

Tobias: I forgot the Jesus Yantra.

**Swami:** ... (Laughter)

Brett: Sri Chakra...

**Swami:** Ok, tomorrow evening you're drawing the yantras. You're writing honestly the prayers. No compromise. Then next again my subject is healing techniques. That is the subject you have to learn, healing techniques, like 1,008 healing techniques. It's done. Heal the spirits, heal the mind, heal the heart, heal all different angles - that's you have to learn it. Try to print it Myuri, what I already given before, the healing techniques. Why, you smiling? (Laughter)

Myuri: (smiles and shrugs) Yes.

**Swami:** How many techniques I already given?

Myuri: It's many, many...

**Swami:** Like two hundred, three hundred?

Myuri: It'll take some time to get Christmas time 1999 and...

**Swami:** Can you get it in two or three days? Pull it.

Myuri: Probably three or four days.

**Swami:** Ok. Get within three, four days. Ok? Good. Good luck guys. Thank you.
