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**Swami:** Welcome my Dear Divine Souls. 2006 - 2007 the University of Sri Kaleshwar Soul University. Today I'm closing that. Almost a hundred and twenty-one students learned amazing things, practiced, graduated. Being in the Swami Kaleshwar umbrella for one year is quite amazing. What I dreamed since my journey started in 1998 with strong inspiration, almost nine, ten years. Today I feel very confident and authentic you guys will create amazing success in your lives in the globe.

But in the knowledge what you learned, the processes what you've been through, I sincerely recommend, don't get anywhere compromised. The knowledge what you received, try to use in the society for the good. Whenever you're using the energy, the channels in any negative way for your own selfishness, you will lose on the day that energy. That's my word and the Guru Parampara word.

Your lives are for yourself and majority for society. I can say you're the guys who got the doctorates as the Soul Specialists. Can get many doctorates to the services of this and that, but you know how to handle the souls, the depressed persons. As depression and psychiatric doctors, they can give some hormone tablets, but you know the feelings of the person to give the enlightenment to the person step-by-step. You have that capability. Never, ever feel unworthy that you cannot do the work. I'm sincerely saying you can do it. You will do it!

You're seeing your Swami's life since nine, ten years majority people who have been with me. Almost eighteen hours per day I've been working. Even to my wife, she heartfully cooperated and she stayed with her mother. She gave the permission to complete this university process to the university students. She sacrificed. No woman will generally do to that extent. Even for a day I walk with her only like thirty or forty minutes. Sometimes for four or five days I never even talk to her face to face - only by phone. I keep on saying to her, "It's also a part of your duty." She's also cooperated a lot. Since when I met her until now, it's really quite amazing.

And also, who really worked with me in the office, Anya, Cyndria, Johanna, Birte, Terry, Paul and Monika T. Without them, today this university, this much time and this much knowledge, I'm not able to share it with you guys. Sincerely I heartfully thank them. Even late night, I'm coming to Bangalore from any abroad countries... from Germany if I landed in Bangalore midnight, at 2:30 I land to the ashram, Terry and Cyndria they're awake. They put the office clean. They know what I need exactly. They're waiting for me. Even though you're giving any millions of dollars of salary, you cannot get such type of pure with loving and affection welcoming. And to wake up at 7 a.m. again they have to be in the office on their job by 9:30, or 10.

So why I'm saying this, you have to tune your mind, your heart, your soul, to the dedication. Once you're dedicated to your work, you won't feel the stress. Whenever there is no dedication, then you start to feel the stress. Once the concentration is there you'll definitely win it. Generally, before I'm going to any country, one week I start to get little phobia, "Ok, I have to go. Oh, I have to go." Then counting the days. Three days is left. Even ten days before I ask the staff, "When am I flying? When I'm returning back?" I always have the return ticket one day in advance. Once I land, there the reservations keep running to reach India.

It's not homesick. You know my nature, once the work is done then I'm not the person to be enjoying sightseeing. Only one time I had the sightseeing in my life, with my wife in London in the UK. I'm serious. She brought me to the museum, little bit traveling here and there, that's it. Did I do any sightseeing in Germany guys? Tobias?

Tobias: No. No sightseeing.

**Swami:** No. No sightseeing. In America no sightseeing. Any country huh-un, straight landing, going in hotel, complete my work, come back to the room, come to the airport and take off.

I can see the sight scenes but instead of seeing the sight scenes, better to think the same time about my students. Even though you didn't think about yourself, I really think about you more than what you think in our life. Take it granted. Every single student who was here was completely fed into my brain, into the computer. "What is he? What is the process doing? What's going on? What are his blocks? What is his main problem? What I can give him? What I can receive from him? How I really can train him? In which angle I can put him in success? It's almost ten years amazing hard work.

If this is the students' problem - hard work, another part especially with the Indian's society, the Indian traditions, their belief systems, how much they're pulling me down – their disturbances. The press, politicians, police, this PPP (press/politicians/police) these guys they're the kind of powerful monsters. They're the monsters. To deal with them I have to be strong monster.

So, so far our Big Boss, no doubt every step what I walk, that's his doing it. Every moment what he's making in my life, that's him doing it. The same thing I'm saying today to you guys, every moment whatever is happening in your life, that is nothing but Baba's decision. A hundred percent take it for granted - you are in the Sai Parampara Family. Even you want to escape it, that's impossible. Like a tiger, once it got the meat in the mouth, if the tiger loses it, then Baba loses it. The tiger never loses that meat so Baba never, ever loses you. Even you hate him, you don't like him, he's putting lot of testings, you've been through a lot of unbelievable stress, that's good. Tell him, "That's coming from him." That's not your stress, that's his stress. That is? His stress. Your problem is not your problem. Actually we don't have any problems. We don't have any problems. He's the problem. Sorry to say, he's the problem. We are living in the middle of the problem so we don't need to think about problems any more.

So, he's amazing kind, mercy, dedicated soul. Once if you look at him, ask heartfully, "Help. Please take care of this." His help, his energy is all the time with you. You have to recognize that to receive that. And this class, this university, what I saw some examination papers, the first rank student is Paul A. - first rank. Second rank student is Myuri. Finally the third rank student is Tatyana. These three characters, pretty good they understood the subject, the knowledge and the depth almost 99% equal to the Swami. Take it granted. They really need to develop some more in some corners but pretty good they can get success.

In the Vaastu subject I'll give to the Tobias, Clint, and Ramakrishna. These guys are bullets. They know the Vaastu, take it granted. And Germany side, once if you think, Ganesh is also pretty good coming, but he needs to develop some more depth in the Vaastu subject. So now I want to give a piece of paper. It's nothing but... in the coming days you don't need to be recognized from the government. You need to be recognized from the Guru Paramparas - that is the Soul University.

What is the first name? Aghni. Starting with the Fire Element. Congratulations.

*(Swami now gives out one by one a diploma to each student and shakes their hand.)*

**Swami:** Good. Wow, you guys squeezed my hand. Anya, can you stand up. What is your comment to receiving this paper?

Anya: To me it shows the greatness of your understanding and awareness of every human being that comes in your path. Otherwise I never would have received something like this from you. *(can't hear the rest.)*

**Swami:** Luzia, what is your comment?

Luzia: I can say at the beginning of the university I had my doubts that the majority could change so fast and so easily. So this paper to me is recognizing how much the people they changed. I wouldn't have thought that it would be possible.

**Swami:** Soul University. Swami Kaleshwar Soul University. Soul means in Telugu?

Students: Atma.

**Swami:** It means from my soul, from my Atma, whenever I take a pen putting a stroke reading your name, what I recognized you, signing it. It means it's not a sign on the paper. It's a sign on your soul guys. It's a sign on your souls to be truthful, loyal to the divine energy forever and ever until to your last breath. You're here for the society. You're here for creating the peace in the globe. You're here to take care of the suffering people. Even though you're so busy, you have tons of work with your family life, but that sign is making a knocking at the door of your soul, "You have to help. You have to help." That's the most important thing what I'm expecting from you guys. What guru dakshina I'm asking today from you, guys, "Help ever - hurt never." Try to do as much as you can the social service.

Even though you're taking care of a lot of spiritual activities, the same another part, the symbol of the ashram. You see how many thousands of people are gathered here, how many thousands of charitable activities we're taking, how many thousands of feeding the poor we're taking care, giving to the blind people eye operations, giving clothing, performing weddings, and giving sewing machines, tricycles to the handicapped, doing the medical camps, and even to the University many people couldn't afford, just completely giving the scholarship taking care of you. It means you're seeing this symbol of the ashram to do the charitable services.

Today you're drinking a glass of wine. The same time you have to think thousands of children in the globe - they don't have a glass of milk. Today you're wearing the costly dress - somebody doesn't have enough cloth on their body. All the time, whenever you start thinking on somebody else, orphans, old people, AIDS patients, mentally retarded children, that's direct seva what you can do either directly or indirectly. Certain things I'm doing it and making you to do it also guys.

Whenever you start creating the peace in the globe, whenever you turn the peace the inner silence that's in you, then you really can create the peace in the globe. You already have the inner silence. Just

I told it like a kind of joke and comment, “We really don’t have any problems.” It’s a serious comment. The problems are clouds, it comes and it goes. The real problem is around us to taking care of somebody’s happiness. Whenever we’re taking care of somebody’s happiness, that happiness will reflect back to us the real Satchitananda, the real Chinmayananda.

From ten years until to now I almost never, ever think about myself. Can you believe it or not? It’s a serious. I don’t care about my health. I don’t care about my food, when to sleep, when to eat – completely until I go on the bed I’m thinking on the people, “How to do, how to create, where my service can be utilized, how to utilize in a proper way.” That type of motivation, that type of inspiration you have to bring, you have to live with that, you have to stay with that until your last breath. Promise?

Gustav: We have a beautiful program for you Swami.

**Swami:** To me, what is that?

Gustav: A beautiful reflection. We knew that something is going to happen today what you want to give us, so we were thinking what we can give you.

**Swami:** Ok.

Gustav: So we prepared a little bit. Can we start with that now?

**Swami:** Sure.

Gustav: We'll start with the pictures.

Charlotte: Swami we had so many treasurable moments this year. And we wanted to give you this photo that reflects one of those moments in Hampi when Swami was with us and we were all together at the Shiva Virupaksha Temple. We're so grateful Swami and we love you so much.

*(Charlotte presents the large framed picture of the University Power Journey in Hampi, September 2006.)*

**Swami:** Oooh, thank you! Yes, I need that photo.

Ganga: Swami, all of us here at the University for this 2006 - 2007 year could probably speak many hours of our gratitude to you – hundreds, thousands of hours... words could not possibly express our gratitude to you. They say a picture is worth a thousand words. We hope this picture is worth the millions of words that we would speak to you.

*(Ganga presents the large framed picture of the University students on the front lawn of the ashram.)*

**Swami:** Wow. It's necessary.

Gustav: And then we had the thought that maybe one person should say something from the student's body to you, to your family. So it came to me that I can say something from my heart and that is, when I came here first, Swami was showing me that my life was not that happy, that I thought I didn't know, I didn't know how heartbroken I was. And Swami took me in his hands, "I know, I know," and he guided me through all these days that I'm standing here now. And everyone could be standing here. And I thought about why I'm taking this speech, why I'm the person now. I have so many blocks... I'm doing so many mistakes. I just had an arguing in the morning with somebody. Oh my God, what can I say? But there must be a reason why I'm here now, talking now. And the reason I found in myself is, it's his (Baba) plan. He wants me to talk. And another part is, I really want to be a part of that mission of Swami Kaleshwar. I really want to do everything I can, everything that is possible in my

life to support you. Whatever it is, with my music, my family, whatever I can do to really support and bring that message to all the people in the whole world.

This University for me is a sign of the growing family. I really do believe in our family. Swami gave me a new family and this is my home. *(Chinello reads to Swami the University Student's Pledge)*

Chinello: It's our commitment to Swami and the Guru Parampara with humility and gratitude, we the family of students of Sri Kaleshwar Soul University, with open hearts and clear mind, to honor and uphold the following, we call it the Nine Commitments:

1. To maintain the purity of the divine knowledge and teachings as given by Sri Kaleshwar.
2. To embody and support the unity and harmony of our family of teachers.
3. To acknowledge and remember it's not *me* but the Guru Parampara operating through me wherever I am on the planet.
4. To be responsible for my actions and to practice forgiveness of my self and others, and have a loving and accepting nature.

5. To help relieve suffering in the world wherever I can.
6. To keep my inspiration high and be an inspiration to others.
7. To wash my own blocks and to wash the negativity of other souls wherever I can.
8. To do my maximum best to lift any soul coming to me for help.
9. To know and practice Satya, Dharma, Shanti, Prema.

So this is our gift from our deepest gratitude and love to you Swamiji.

**Swami:** So beautiful. Thank you so much.

Gustav: So we were thinking how to make it a pledge. That was the idea. All the University students and everyone who wants to participate in this pledge, we're going to sing the Guru Mantra three times.

*(Everyone chanted the Guru Mantra three times)*

**Swami:** Thank you so much guys. And I really appreciate your dedication, your pledge. No matter what, where you are in any position, the Guru Parampara is with you. It will take care of you until your last breath. It's my word!

Simone: Sorry, I didn't want to have the last word. There's something else to say. So because we all received more than we all could have imagined, we wanted to give something back to society. And what Swami mentioned before, charity work is a great part of this life and it should become more and more a part of our lives. And so we collected a little money, and that is more like a symbol that we wanted to give to the ashram to buy firewood to the dhuni where day-by-day our karmas are burned. So the pockets of all students are pretty empty so we want to give back something to Penukonda so we're all leaving now, but we all have beautiful things we might donate to the orphanage here in Penukonda, like pencils, papers, maybe beautiful towels and bed sheets. So it would be great to collect those things and give as a symbol out to Penukonda and to the

people over there. So hopefully it's a big start of something growing more and more. Thank you Swami.

*(Gustav begins the song the bhajan group prepared especially for this graduation celebration)*

Gustav: Swami we were thinking a long time what we could say to you at the very end of this University. And even if we tried hard it's only one thing we can say, we want to say and that's 'Thank You.'

Chorus: Thank you, thank you, thank you. Thank you, thank you, thank you.

Mutiam: I just have to say that ever since I was very young, not that young, but young, I knew I needed to meet somebody in my life who could give me some answers. I didn't think I'd meet this great saint in Los Angeles of all places. I was wearing black of course, sitting in the front row. But I did and as I'm sitting in front of Swami, completely nervous, kind of right now, I couldn't even look him in the eye but I was looking up. To his right, of course, where Baba was and I'm looking at Baba and all of the sudden I realized that the talk stopped and Swami's looking at me. And I looked at Swami sheepishly and he looked at me and he looked and he sees Baba and he gave me a smile and he said, "Who wants to come to India?" As I was thinking about how I could get the money, and that would be great to go to India some day, and I'm looking around at all the hands that are up, I realized that my hand had gone up first. Here I am nine years later with another University student on the way. Thank you so much Swami.

And thank you for all your blessings. Thank you.

Chorus: (repeat the refrain) Thank you, thank you, thank you. Thank you, thank you, thank you. Thank you, thank you, thank you.

Annette H.: Dear Swamiji, here we are your divine family. Finally you made it. And as a beautiful result we show our gratitude by sharing the love and the knowledge we received from you and our beloved lineage in the purest, highest, divine way. You made us happy and we hope and we wish to make you happy. Let's go, thank you.

Chorus: (Repeat the refrain) Thank you, thank you, thank you. Thank you, thank you, thank you. Thank you, thank you, thank you.

Eric: Swamiji, when I was a very young child, I was very sick and I had to cry out to Jesus Christ. And he helped me and he showed me something that night. And then twenty-five years later, when I thought I was about to take off in a storm in the ocean, again I was praying to Jesus and I made a deal and I said, "Please save me Jesus. If you save me I will teach the world about you." And he did. And the only guy who could do that, to help me to walk in the footsteps of Jesus is you. And you took that responsibility - a tough, tough job. Thank you Swamiji, thank you for that.

**Swami:** You're welcome.

Chorus: (Finale) Thank you, thank you, thank you. Thank you, thank you, thank you. Thank you, thank you, thank you.

**Swami:** Thank you.

Gustav: it's going to be forever together - together forever - Together forever - Together forever - Forever together - Together forever.

*(Annette H. brings Swami a pink pillow. Immediately Navya walks over and picks up the pillow and takes it over to her grandmother and puts it in her lap and puts her head down to rest on the pillow.)*

**Swami:** It's beautiful, wonderful – true open heart. On the moment true open hearts. It is true. But all these open hearts today he (Baba) made it, not me, the Big Bosses – Baba and Jesus. These guys are totally with us to make today to open these beautiful open hearts. So

I heartfully thank to Baba and Big Boss to make this year and this journey super successful and very peaceful. We've taken off from the ground. The ground speed is over. Boarding is over, ground speed is over, everybody is comfortable in your seats but the landing situation will also be very easy. The landing is to bring the ancient knowledge in the planet. It's my request, order to everybody who witnessed today, doesn't matter which religion you belong to, doesn't matter which belief system you're carrying, it matters what you're reading, what you're seeing with your own eyes that knowledge. It needs to come out in the globe. Then the spirituality really comes fruitful.

Even though the science, or different crazy people think you're a crazy cult, or any defames, you have to recognize that's natural once you're in spirituality. How much you're really facing the negativity, and facing the defames and facing the punches, that much you'll shine it. Take it granted. Never think it's obstacles. No. Even though they think you're crazy, what you believe in it – southwest swimming pool, southwest entrance, southwest slope, east mountain you should not live there – somebody thinks you're crazy but you know the realities.

It took to me almost ten years to write the Vaastu book, almost all to last year. And I tested it, practiced it, same like what you believe in it. Don't get compromised. To your eyes it's a red color, a blue color. Stick on that. To somebody's eyes it might look black, dark... Ten people are seeing it's a black, but you're seeing it's a blue, stick on with the blue. Whenever you start to compromise you cannot win the spirituality. Even though thousands of people are pulling you down, keep climb it. Even though you're exhausted, you're tired, you gave up, still hold the inspiration you can do it, you can climb it, you can win it. You will do that.

So my life is also an example what I've been through and what I've seen in many people's personal life – no money, no aim, terrible depressions on the blocks, I can leave you like that but I can't leave you. But same time I've seen in you lot of great qualities holding you, slowly bringing you. Whenever I'm bringing you towards the divine side to the beautiful side, your own blocks are driving you crazy and me crazy - no idea. But same way, once you're dedicated you want to learn it, you want to win it. Whenever you're in your countries you have free time - buy Telugu books, buy a Telugu books. Have a look

on it. Even though it takes ten years, fine, twenty more years, fine. The information is available.

By grace of Baba, so far what I've done, it's well protected the knowledge, the information. It will come out one day. Learn Telugu, see in the ancient days the prayers, the slokas, the channels what they really made it inside. Once that information comes out, all the colored feathers of bird in one tree looks so beautiful. It really looks so beautiful. It will really fulfill the tree fragrance. You need to suck all the global wide the people, their belief systems on one tree. That's your mission. You can only do that once you have authentic knowledge, authentic confidence then you'll win it. Then you really can create lot of wisdom in the globe. As a bhakti way, hundreds of thousands of people know about Swami Kaleshwar. As my real students, as really strong healers, as strong characters I need to create how to do that, how to do that. Finally I made that. I'm giving the burden, also until my last breath I'm carrying the burden but I'm also giving 50% of the burden on you guys today.

So whenever I call, whenever every Guru Purnima gather as a family and celebrate. This is your house. This is your Soul Power Place. Have a wonderful day and today we need to do the Shiva Process to dig the hole and put him, the most powerful Shiva Lingam inside. It'll take maybe ten, fifteen hours to dig that and bury that. And every person needs to touch that and put him in the ground, in the earth element. And the next Guru Purnima, wherever you are, even though any problems you're having, even you can't come next Christmas or Shiva Ratri, try to hit the next Guru Purnima and dig him and pull him out. I'll explain next Guru Purnima what is that Shiva Lingam, the most power energy that's hidden in it. There are many Shiva Lingams that look like that but it's a Character Shiva Lingam – pure high powerful element's energies. It's good to your soul to touch next Guru Purnima. Anyhow, everybody touched this time too isn't it?

Some students: No.

**Swami:** Ok you can start to flow now, take it and hear that.

*(Digging the hole for the Shiva Lingam outside the Dwarkamai)*

And outside the Dwarkamai to the east near the steps, once the steps are over twenty feet later, 9 x 9 to 25 feet depth. You guys - strong gents and ladies help to make a hole. We'll put him tonight there. Then I'll explain tomorrow the channels how to use the Shiva Lingam. So today is the process, we'll do that. Then tomorrow is the vibhutti abhishek and with lotus petals, all different types of flowers and milk, we'll put him in the ground. That is today's program. Carry on. Have a wonderful day.
