Making a Deal With Baba for the Lotus Process
Talk in Front of the Dwarkamai
June 29, 2008



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Making a deal with Baba to help with the Lotus Process. A few minutes in the beginning are missing. Here are some points from the memory of different people.

(Swami commented on the fact that there was too much weight of rocks in the northeast of the Dwarkamai covering the knives. Swami said, "Just put a basket." We should uncover it once the rain comes. He looked at the drainpipe above and said, "Let it come down. The water has to flow down." (The steps to the garden from the slates) Once the rain comes, everybody should go out in the garden and take a shower, even I am taking a sandalwood shampoo. Pray to Baba for the rain. Swami looked at the sky and said, "I have been waiting for rain for nine, ten days. Once the rain comes, the lotus process starts. If rain doesn't come within the next week, forget the process until 2011.)

The following is from memory: After 24 hours all your processes will be done*). No more clothes, no more clothes. Take off the sari. Put on some flowers. (*Swami was talking about the Jesus statue that Ganga and the gents carved out of stone*)

Swami: What are you doing, guys?

Eric: Preparing for Guru Purnima, making some torches.
