

**Ashram Talks With Swami**  
An Invitation to Visit Swami's New House in Cuddapah  
Talk in the Baba Temple  
July 28, 2009



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*(Swami comes down to bhajans)*

**Swami:** Excellent. Excellent. What does it mean by ananda sagara? Sagara means ocean and ananda means bliss - the ocean of the bliss. It's a small announcement, on Friday morning by 6:30.... First of all, how many people in the ashram guys?

Clint: Seventy-one.

**Swami:** Seventy-one? Okay, forty-five people I'm inviting in the bus to Kadapa. I'm opening the new house where I was born in that place. We've built a beautiful house there. It's a kind of little Lila Palace. It's a kind of, little Lila Palace. You're starting here by 6:30 sharp, here after you're finishing your tiny breakfast, and all red saris and gents white dhotis. By again from there you're leaving after the lunch. By one you left by there. You'll be here around 4:30, 5. It's a 3 ½ to 4 ½ hour drive.

I hope the office they'll organize the bus from Bangalore - good bus, good condition. I don't think you'll feel sick like the Hampi. It's a nice car and few guys need to stay in ashram to take care, and 45 people the bus capacity so you can choose and make a few group leaders - let's go, let's you visit.

And Thursday and Friday I won't be in the official headquarters. Friday is the main official opening. Thursday is the pujas performing there. Then you'll see this is the culture of the Bangalore style, this Penukonda, like a Bangalore belt, a Karnataka belt. Within twenty-five minutes you reach the Karanataka border. That border is Tamil Nadu border. You

know what I'm saying, Tirupati and Tamil Nadu. From there Tirupati is one and a half hour drive. That's where my house is we built there. So you can see the people how they're really... the way of their dress, their style, the bullock cart - it's so interesting.

Generally I don't like that place, first of all... put it that way. Even I'm driving by that village, that town, even my parents they're staying there... I take the bypass to go to Tirupati. Whatever I don't like it, Baba intentionally he made me to marry there. Then I thought I was going to build a small house, like two bedrooms, like a Constanze house, like that... storage, then it's whrwww, it's really quite... Step-by-step Chitti Babu, he built that, step by step, step by step. Huge the front door, an elephant cannot open it, a strong elephant if it really hitted it - no chance. If anybody wants to break the house with ax, cut the wood, takes four people whole night, four people. It's a beautiful sculpture they drew on the door. It's a kind of little western style Indian tradition there.

So, generally I don't like that type of houses. My real house is hut. The hut and my dhuni spot - happy. Maybe after 2011 I'll turn as a business magnate, then I'm in that house. Clint saying, I think a couple days back, "Swami should be really stay little more long time in spirituality. You're the central..." what you said?

Clint: Center of the wheel.

**Swami:** "You're the center of the wheel. No way, you have to. The people only believing in, only following you... this, this, this..." like non-stop forty-five minutes he kept talking. I said, "Okay, well fine. Okay, well... thanks, alright, okay." Because of, he came to check my blood pressure of my health, then he caught me. Then relaxly I said... Then he kept on and on and on and on and on... I'm thinking, "What are all these guys putting sankalpam on me?" You know what I'm saying? Whatever I'm teaching on Kalachakra and Kamachakra, if you use that on me - I'm in trouble, like Parameshwara gave to Bhasmasura one boon.

You know Bhasmasura? Whoever he put his hand on their head, they will turn as ash. Shankara gave that boon. "If you guys want to implement on me that, hun-un, you're in trouble." Then that guy wanted to first test on Shiva, "You gave that boon. I want to test it, if it's really playing, happening, or not."

Of course I trust you, I know your personal mantra. I don't think so, but still chance there. Good, so Friday morning 6:30, so Clint and Simon, few guys... when are you leaving Simon?

Simon: Well I was going to leave at 6:30 on Friday morning.

**Swami:** That's why I'm seeing your face is little reddish, like something's... what's wrong? So you're organizing your ticket, all the stuff?

Simon: Yea, we can change it, no problem.

**Swami:** No, it's okay, can go, it's fine. Done? So you all guys are invited, fine, Friday 6:30.
