Students Respond to Swami's Book on Jesus

Teaching in the Baba Temple

December 26, 2009



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Swami: How much you read the book today?

Monika T: About fifty percent, Swami.

Swami: Fifty percent?

Monika T: Yes, we did in two groups, German and English speaking, so forty-five percent.

Swami: Again it came down five percent less. What is your feeling?

Gary: Swami, it's the most beautiful, powerful words I have ever heard. And I was... it really is the fulfillment, I know your dream for the last twelve years, but my life, and it's just forty-five percent of Volume One, and it was read beautifully. Words just powerfully hit me. Thank you.

Swami: That's not I wanted? How much you really understood... which direction I'm going, Patrick.

Patrick: You mean like with the future volumes, or just the... well Swami, my feelings listening to it was it was a beautiful balance of punching, respecting, that's what I... to all the communities that were being punched. Really, I was amazed by that, I was amazed by that, and maybe that's what you're not looking for right now either but...

Swami: Then I punched it, or I am going to be punched too?

Patrick: It was punching.

Swami: It was already punching?

Patrick: It was absolutely punching. Some points for sure but the same time, I thought was an amazing balance of respecting everybody's belief systems, at the same time, you're just giving your information as you... and you found a...follow the way, that was my last feeling.

Swami: Constanze.

Constanze: Well, I enjoyed also your language that you used. It was a scientific way, so you give it back in the same words that you received a lot of many criticism, but you give it back in a very nice way to challenge the science. But I think the arguments are so clear, we have to chew a lot.

Swami: What does she say?

Constanze: They have to do a lot of work to digest and to bring something up, if they can find something.

Swami to Monika T: Explain. Her accent is different.

Monika T: She said you explained a lot of things very scientifically to really make the arguments to understand, and that she's digesting that.

Constanze: No, the science has to digest that. The science is challenged and they... well, they have to look in a mirror and see what's there, which skeleton is there. So you use a very neutral language, not emotional, so it's very clear understandable for scientific persons.

Swami: It means I am not emotional character?

Constanze: Well, there is a lot of love hidden of course, and you speak about the importance of love and power of course, so each spiritual person understands the love behind. But I think for scientific person, it's also important to have... just to handle facts and they have to look for facts, and that will give them some headache for sure.

Swami: Headaches to whom?

Constanze: To the scientific persons and to Rome.

Swami: What she said?

Student: To Rome.

Swami: Vatican? What happened to the Pope last night?

Constanze: Yes, yes he was attacked by a woman.

Swami: Nancy.

Nancy: He was... a woman jumped over a fence and pulled the pope down to the ground.

Swami: It has already started. It has already? started.

Gary: Swami, since I went one direction which I still heartfully... may I go another direction?

Swami: Sure.

Gary: For me, what I took away was Jesus' mission clearly is your mission, is our mission, and this Volume One already has punched and will punch, and we have to stand and deliver now - it's our duty, it's our job. And it really put that in front of me more clearly, more powerfully than I have ever had it in front of me.

Swami: Of course it's your job. That is? your job to carry this fragrance to the globe. It's your job. But even though many people get filter out, but it'll come out. I'm doing my duty, do your duty too. Keep worrying and be panic, why you need to be panic? Why you need to be panic? No need to be panic. Reality is reality. So second volume, it will be more... so when will you be completed, by tomorrow night?

Monika T: Yes, we can finish it by tomorrow night.

Swami: I think that tomorrow is the program ends, isn't it?

Student: Yes, Christmas program.

Swami: Christmas program ends, so you are coming out with the different questions, and with your some clarifications and... you are writing down guys?

Students: Yes.

Swami: Only I'll give the chance really crystal clear English who speaks, not wasting of the time, and two, three people giving a piece of paper printing, and you have a copy, and everybody has a copy that questions, that clarification I will give it. Somebody reading to me, then I will explain it. Clear?

Students: Yes.

Swami: But don't waste the time for silly questions, you know what I'm saying? Don't waste. It's good. By next Christmas all the Elephant Group and some more senior students are you really going to learn Telugu, guys? I'm giving one-year target time. If you took the Telugu newspaper just read it. If I gave a book, just read it. Then ninety-nine percent my headache is gone. My? headache is gone. I can throw my passport in the dhuni. I'm serious. Whenever I open my cupboard my passport is sitting there, "Ah, ya, just throw it." If you really can do the hard work it's possible, it's possible. Then if your life is really dedicated certain period of time, once you got certain information, the knowledge, that evidences – yes, you can change the globe. You can change the globe.

How many people really know and believe the Vaastu in the world? Not even 0.0000001%. No. They believe in Feng Shui. Un-hun, I respect Feng Shui but it's not one hundred percent clear. I give only five marks to that. I'll give the? five marks. So it's... everything is practically I tested it, and proved it, and I've seen it, then I put it in front of you. Then you no need to listen my talks - just whatever is existing in the books, the yantras, and mantras, and prayers, all the script you read it, you draw it, and you explain it. Is nowadays is possible, Clint, to write that ancient palm leaf books, even any technology is there?

Clint: No, not to prepare the leaves. How to make the leaves; how to prepare them; and write on them; and what to use to write; and how to write them, no, and then the language is used, it's no doubt it's ancient.

Swami: I keep reading, reading, reading, reading and my eyes is got little irritated. When I went to Manipal hospital to master checkup, what is that called that she mentioned?

Clint: Glucoma.

Swami: Glucoma, I don't know what it is.

Clint: High pressure in your eyes.

Swami: High pressure, and they scanned it, and the pressure is there and she's suspecting, "Now you have to go this test, that test, this test." Finally they put me in the machine, my head, and I have to make click where there is tiny spotlights, and they are driving me crazy. They put the drops in my eyes and... I have eye hospital, I take care thousands of old people and I made them to get operated and why is... no, she said no, something wrong and you need to get... okay fine. After thirty-five, forty minutes later, again she put another, what is the final test that is?

Clint: They dilated your eyes again, and then they put a lense right on top of your eyeball and looked inside.

Swami: That tiny letters, and keep reading and it's affected. Then finally she checked, "Well, I didn't find anything problem here. Something you're unusual character. All tests is okay and positive, positive, this one came negative, and you're unusual character." I said, "Thanks, can I go now?" Jump out. So it's... thank God and... if my eyesight goes bad and wrong, absolutely no way I can read it. No way? I can read it.

But whatever it is, so, as your group senior students, I'll support you guys in all angles. You no need to pay anything, even to the Telugu masters whoever it is, I'll take care. Just you sit with a strong determined mind, focus it. The clock is running, running, running - don't waste the time. Don't? waste the time.

Whatever I'm teaching, my part is giving you some experiences, mechanisms... That part is okay but you personally saw it and practiced it and got it, that is the thrill. That is the thrill. Never know the maya chakra how long, how far I can exist anymore but whatever the auspicious things are available in front of you, utilize in a proper way. I know it's a little painful with your responsibilities and attachments. If you want something, you need to lose something. If you want everything, it's not possible. Do you know what I'm saying? To make one hundred percent everything perfect, and judgment, to give the right judgment on all your duties, it's difficult. Your aim needs to be, if you want to learn Telugu, yes learn Telugu. On the days in the palm leaf books, how they written it. They sacrificed their lives. It's not a joke - they sacrificed, they tested it. It's a supernatural science. They tested it and finally they put it in a book. It means absolutely you don't need to suspect their channelings, their? channelings.

Adi Shankaracharya is the top guy who discovered the Sri Chakra. There's many Sri Chakras but whatever your Swami mentioned to you, the Sri Chakra, 99.9% similar, 99.9% is similar. You're making your life lot of money, and the name and fame - that's good. But the same time, even though it's a little difficult to jump in, take the real commitment. Real? commitment. By the next Christmas, even the senior students are not able to read the Telugu, they'll lose their apartments and they can't come back to ashram and India. I think I need to be tough enough, isn't it? I'm not threatening but I am threatening. Since years I keep telling. Today if anybody can really read crystal clear the Telugu and some Kannada words, somebody can stand up and just read it. Tobias is pretty good, Paul is good, Monika T. is good, Clint is good - they're picking up, they're almost all they're coming up. Two more steps, once they come up—done. Done.

If you have a crew who can really learn Telugu, then whichever your country, then you can make a programing how you can learn it. You can establish a big... even in Germany one university, just for hiring a Telugu professors to making you to teach. In America one professor, university, or schools, possible, then you come to the knowledge straightly.

So, there's a lot of unbelievable secret things hidden in the palm leaf books, not only the Jesus life, there's tons of things. You can't imagine, tons of unbelievable secret things they written it - that

information to pull out and to giving to the globe. What you need more than that? What you need more than that?

So I'm looking forward to seeing by tomorrow, once you completed and spend maybe tomorrow whole night, whole book and just we'll go through the review of the book, the questionnaires and clarifications on the Big Boss, what he practiced, some channelings, some mechanisms, some depth. Think one group is left to get the initiation. We'll see.
